




# Facilitating Remote Access to Content

## Create an Individual JoVE Account

Students and faculty can [create an account](#) with an institutional email to access JoVE videos off-campus.

## Google Single Sign-On

If your school uses Gmail, you can use Google SSO (single sign-on) to log in. This allows you to remotely access JoVE content with your institution's Gmail credentials.

## Embed JoVE Videos in Your Online Courses

## Sign-On Using Shibboleth Or OpenAthens
